Course Title:	Strategic Thinking and Results
Designed For:	Senior leaders and executives.

Course Title:	Road Map: Continuous Process Improvement
Designed For:	Process managers and owners
Course Description:	<p>Although there are a number of methodologies available to address structured problem solving and continuous improvement, the Road Map methodology has been used globally because of its flexibility and ease of use. This program utilizes the structured approach of the Road Map, which is based entirely on the DMAIC logic (Define, Map and Measure, Analyze, Improve and Control). This approach can be easily adapted for use in various problem solving and process improvement opportunities. The Road Map is the perfect vehicle for linking process improvement with the needs of both internal and external customers. It can also be used for internal projects without customer collaboration for significant process improvement and process efficiency gains.</p> <p>After completing this workshop, participants will be able to:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Collaborate with others to eliminate process inefficiency.• Improve process velocity and process capability while reducing costs.• Take a holistic; end to end approach to process improvement.• Build the discipline of solving process issues by driving to root causes rather than solving them by reacting to symptoms of the root cause.
